A selection of small fossils, including ammonites and sharks teeth, packed into 18 compartment clear plastic box

3 x complete polished ammonite fossils (large – approx. 12cm diameter, medium – approx. 11cm diameter, small – approx. 6.5cm diameter)

1 x complete unpolished ammonite fossil (approx. 12cm diameter)

6 x segments of ammonite fossils

Urchin fossil (approx. 4.5cm diameter)

Selection of magnifying cubes containing – 6 x ammonite fossils, 3 x fossilised shark's teeth, 1 x nautiloid fossil, 1 x amber chunk with insects

3 x plastic Nautilus replicas

Set of 11 mini replica dino skulls (index sheet in blue folder)

Set of 14 mini plastic dinosaurs (index sheet in blue folder)
