Do you enjoy helping children learn? Why not join our team of learning volunteers at Weston Museum? We are looking for volunteers to assist with school visits to the museum and with our children's events during school holidays.

Volunteer tasks:

You will assist our learning and events officer with the creation and delivery of learning sessions for school visits and other educational groups.

Transferable skills you can gain from this role:

- Experience of working in a learning environment
- Communication skills
- Experience of working with children
- Increased confidence and wellbeing
- Historical knowledge
- Health and Safety awareness
- Safeguarding awareness
- Other role specific training

Skills required: Confidence and the desire to work with children is very important for this role as well as a friendly approachable manner. An enthusiastic approach to learning is a firm requirement when working with children and an awareness of safeguarding principles would be an advantage, but full training is given.

Potential time involvement: The museum is open 6 days a week in the winter and 7 days a week in the summer from 10am – 5pm; a typical shift for this role is either a morning or an afternoon subject to booking requirements.

Responsible to: Learning and Events Officer.

Training and Support: Full training will be given alongside ongoing support from staff and other volunteers as needed. **Out of pocket expenses are paid.**
